TransitCare is committed to identifying and reducing environmental impacts from its operations and to this end will implement a formal Environmental Management System (EMS) compliant with ISO 14001:2015.

The Environmental Management System applies to all TransitCare operations and services and will

define objectives and targets to minimise the organisations' environmental footprint by working with staff members and other stakeholders.

TransitCare will work to achieve continual environmental improvement and prevention of pollution through the development of Environmental Objectives and KPIs within the organisation's strategic and operational plans and systematic review of progress against them.

The ongoing development and effectiveness of the EMS will be achieved through the application of continuous improvement of our systems and processes

Audit and review functions for the EMS will be included within the organisation's Quality Management System but will include at a minimum a review of significant environmental aspects once per calendar year.

Maintenance of relevant standards and legislation will be managed under the organisation's Quality Management System.

TransitCare will communicate to employees; volunteers and suppliers relevant areas of potential impact/environmental aspects; corporate mitigation strategies and progress against defined targets.

New or proposed projects will be assessed for potential change to the organisation's environmental impact and mitigation strategies will be developed for any significant risks identified.
