Different fees apply to our members on Home Care Packages or individual agreements. Please confirm with our Contact Centre team if you are unsure or require clarification.

If you have not provided MyAgedCare codes for Transport or Social Support, this is a requirement by the Government which is needed by 1st July. It is the responsibility of the client to contact MyAgedCare on 1800 200 422 requesting transport and social support codes and providing them to us. We currently have in excess of 2,500 clients that have not provided codes and if they have not been provided to TransitCare, you may not be able to access transport or social support services from the 1st of July. Please provide us with these two codes to ensure continuity of service. We understand you may be on hold to MyAgedCare for a period of time but unfortunately the outcome is beyond TransitCare's control.

## **REGISTERING WITH TRANSITCARE**

Our process to register with Transitcare will differ depending on your individual circumstance.

- 1. If you are eligible for My Aged Care (MAC) you will need to obtain the following:
  - Transport Referral Code (for transport services medical, hospital, health, social)
  - Social Support Group (for our bus trips\*and community hub activities\*\*)
  - Social Support Individual
- 2. If you are not eligible for MAC but have a good reason for not being able to use public transport, please email us for an individual assessment intake@transitcare.com.au
- 3. If you are on a Home Care Package but would like to use or continue using our service, please ask your Home Care Package Provider to email us for more information intake@transitcare.com.au

Our estimated time for registering (onboarding) members is 2-3 weeks. If you are aware of travel required before this timeframe, please let our team know or alternatively call My Aged Care asap 1800 200 422 to start the process.

- \*Bus trips are for all sites except Cairns
- \*\*Community Hub Activities are available to members living in the Logan area and neighbouring

Once registered our team will deliver or post a welcome pack to you, which details our service and how to book with us. We also include a membership form for \$15 per annum. This is voluntary; however, it will register you to vote at our AGM.

## **Clarification – Issue 11 Regarding Car Travel - Front Seat Only:**

Our previous Together magazine provided information regarding Front Seat Only.

The wording requires clarification due to some confusion with members. If you are a 'Front Seat' member there are other options Transitcare can provide OTHER than 'Front Seat' of a car (sedan)

If it is extra leg room, you require due to knee issues or height we have vans which are equipped with automated hoist lifts for members who are not confident with van steps which also have handrails. Due to the limited number of 'Front Seat' cars which will unfortunately delay your transport times, the van option will give you and our team more flexibility to deliver your transport on time. It MAY also allow you to book onto our bus trips which require members the capability of using steps and a certain level of walking (depending on the trip). Let us know if you want to change your 'Front Seat' only status.
