a message FROM THE CEO

Welcome to the Spring edition of TOGETHER Magazine.

While it is great to have reached the end of the colder months, it is hard to believe we are already approaching the end of 2024. We have commenced preparations for our Annual General Meeting in November including putting together the figures for our Annual Report. It is astounding and a little humbling to see that our team has delivered more than 300,000 trips for the 2023/24 financial year. That is an outstanding effort from our entire team and shows their unwavering commitment to meeting the needs of the communities we serve.

This enormous effort has come with a down side as we have now reached our funding capacity for community transport in all areas other than the Gold Coast and have had to temporarily close our books to new transport clients for the first time in the years I have been leading the organisation. In the last financial year, to meet demand, we delivered 4000 more trips than the funding provided. Unfortunately we are not in a position to continue to subsidise services at that rate. Of even more concern to us is the fact that we are also at funded capacity for wheelchair clients. While we have continuously agitated about this issue with both State and Federal governments, to date our requests for assistance have fallen on deaf ears and no further funding has been made available. If you have personal concerns about this issue we encourage you to reach out to your local member of parliament. Our team is working hard to ensure the situation does not affect existing clients and should the State and Federal Government provide more funding we will be able to open our books to assist new clients.

Thank you to all the Clients who have provided us with their My Aged Care transport codes to date. For those who have not yet had the chance, please do so as soon as possible because it is a legislative condition of travelling with TransitCare.

Hopefully most of you have started to see the results of the roll out of our transport SMS notification feature. There have been recent updates to the system so you should now be receiving more accurate approximate arrival times of your transport to help you get ready to leave. If you haven't yet started receiving these messages please speak with our Contact Centre team and they will work with you to arrange access to the system.

We have commenced work on our new home in Beenleigh. It is a very exciting time for the team as we get the site ready for our move early in 2025. We are already counting down the days to



the time we will again have our social support program located back with us and get to see you face to face again, in a room that is purpose built for you. We will share photos as the site takes shape.

Coming into the warmer months I urge you to stay well-hydrated and remain vigilant to look after yourself and your neighbour's well being and safety.

Welcome to Able Australia

The TransitCare team are excited to Welcome aboard all Able Australia clients from the Logan River Valley area. We will officially take over provision of these services from 1st October 2024. We have been able to partner with the Federal Government to assist clients of Able Australia with services who have announced their withdrawal from community transport and social support services. We have been working closely with Able Australia to ensure as little disruption as possible to your transport and social support services during this transition. I encourage anyone joining us from Able to call our Contact Centre team with any questions you may have. When making those calls it will be very helpful for our teams if you could have with you your My Aged Care Transport and Social Support Referral codes.

REGISTERING WITH TRANSITCARE

Our process to register with TransitCare will differ depending on your individual circumstance.

- 1. If you are eligible for My Aged Care (MAC) you will need to obtain the following:
 - Transport Referral Code (for transport services medical, hospital, health, social)
 - Social Support Group (for our bus trips*and community hub activities**)
 - Social Support Individual
- 2. If you are not eligible for MAC but have a good reason for not being able to use public transport, please email us for an individual assessment at intake@transitcare.com.au

Our estimated time for registering (onboarding) members is 2-3 weeks. If you are aware of travel required before this timeframe, please let our team know or alternatively call My Aged Care as soon as possible on 1800 200 422. to start the process.

*Bus trips are for all sites except Cairns.

**Community Hub Activities are available to members living in the Logan area and neighbouring suburbs.

Once registered our team will deliver or post a welcome pack to you, which details our service and how to book with us. We also include a membership form for \$15 per annum. This is voluntary; however, it will register you to vote at our AGM.

TOWNSVILLE UPDATE

Our Townsville members had some memorable lunches over the past few months.

With the cooler weather, we've been able to enjoy some outdoor trips and visited the historic Hervey Range Heritage Tearooms. This building started life as the Eureka Hotel in 1865. After multiple changes of name and ownership, the hotel lost its license in 1908 and since then has been used as a boundary riders hut and a family home and now as a café. It hosted all sorts of events from weddings and birthdays to ghost and tunnel tours. In 2009 it was inducted into the NQ Tourism Awards Hall of Fame. Today, as a café, it serves the biggest scones you've ever seen, and you can buy a cup of the most expensive coffee on the planet – Kopi Luwak (google it!).

We also drove up to the Rollingstone Hotel – it may be only 30mins north of Townsville, but it seems like a different world up there, so peaceful and relaxing and we had a fabulous lunch, after which we drove another 10 minutes up the Bruce Highway to Murtarnee where we all had ice-cream at the renowned Frosty Mango. Here, they have a magnificent orchard of all sorts of exotic tropical fruit trees which are open to visitors. They make their own tropical fruit ice-creams and boy oh boy, are they yum. In August we went to Good Morning Coffee in Townsville for morning tea. This innovative business roasts their own beans and blends their own varieties of coffee on site, and for those of us who may not drink coffee, they also serve tea, hot chocolate, etc.

Over the past couple of months, we went to some of our favourite hotels including the Stuart, Kirwan Tavern, Bushland Beach and the Avenues Tavern for lunches and all in all had a great time catching up with all our friends.

We're all looking forward to the next few months and our annual Christmas luncheon, and a trip to Home Hill for the Craft Spectacular.
